

RULES AND REGULATIONS

OF THE UNDERGROUND CAR PARK AT THE MUSEUM OF THE SECOND WORLD WAR IN GDANSK

- 1. The car park is monitored but not guarded.
- 2. The provisions of the Polish Act of 20 June 1997 on road traffic apply in the car park, and the maximum speed for vehicles is 10 km/h.
- 3. The car park is managed by the Museum of the Second World War in Gdańsk (hereinafter: the Museum), address: Plac Bartoszewskiego 1, Gdańsk 80-862.
- 4. The Museum is not liable for any vehicle loss or damage, and it is not responsible for any items left in vehicles in the car park.
- 5. The car park is open daily from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- 6. Vehicles transporting hazardous materials, in particular flammable, corrosive or explosive materials, or equipped with gas installations, are strictly prohibited from entering the car park.
- 7. Electric cars are prohibited from entering the car park.
- 8. When parking, drivers are required to pay special attention to the nearest vehicles.
- 9. It is forbidden to park a vehicle:
 - a. On access roads and roads joining the traffic;
 - b. In designated and marked areas, except for authorised vehicles;
 - c. In places where parking a car may pose a threat to traffic, people or property.
- 10. It is forbidden to repair, wash or vacuum cars, change coolants, fuel or oil, or litter the car park.

11. Tickets:

- a. Before entering the car park, users must collect a parking ticket from the entry terminal.
- b. The parking fee is payable at the ticket machine in the underground car park or at the information desk at the Museum of the Second World War in Gdańsk,
- c. After paying the parking fee, the vehicle should leave the car park within 15 minutes, otherwise it will be charged for each subsequent hour of parking.
- 12. Authorised Museum employees may check parking privileges.
- 13. The Museum is not responsible for car theft or damage in the car park.

14. PARKING FEE

- a. Museum visitors with a ticket to the Main exhibition (Wednesday–Sunday) free parking for 3 hours only during museum opening hours; each additional hour costs PLN 10.
- b. Museum visitors with a ticket to a temporary exhibition (Wednesday–Sunday) free parking for 1 hour only during the museum opening hours; each additional hour costs PLN 10.
- c. Museum clients half an hour free, then PLN 10 for each started hour.
- d. Tuesday (free admission day) free parking for 30 minutes, then PLN 10 for each started hour.
- e. Cinema-goers discount based on the ticket bought for the screening.

The parking machine accepts payments only by cards.



- 15. Using the car park in any way that breaks these regulations (including, for example, unauthorised entry or exit, parking in two spaces, occupying a space for people with disabilities without authorisation) will result in a fee of PLN 100 for each case.
- 16. Vehicles no taller than 1.90 metres may enter the car park.
- 17. The fee for leaving a vehicle after closing time is PLN 200 for each started day.

The fee for a lost or uncollected ticket is PLN 200.

18. These regulations are valid from 1 October 2025.
