Information notice on the processing of personal data

In accordance with Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (Official Journal of the European Union L 119 of 4 May 2016), I hereby inform you that:

- 1) the controller of your personal data is the Museum of the Second World War, with its registered office in Gdańsk, at pl. W. Bartoszewskiego 1;
